*(from Canon 31) At the first meeting of the Deanery Council in each year, the Regional Dean presiding, the assembled laity shall elect the following (Lay Delegates, Alternate Lay Delegates, Wardens, or Deputy Wardens may be elected):*

- **Youth Members** (up to 2 members, and 1 observer)  
*(It has been customary to give preference to those youth candidates who are in attendance at the Deanery Council meeting at the time of the vote, and for the youth to decide which of them will be the observer. Youth are reminded they are to attend Youth Synod, in the Spring, prior to Synod).*

*\*(Each parish/congregation may elect or appoint one youth member to the Deanery Council. Such person shall be a communicant of at least one year's standing and of the full age of 16 years of age at the time of the election or appointment and not more than 23 years of age at the time of the election or appointment and shall be elected or appointed annually by the Vestry of each parish/congregation at a duly held Vestry meeting. Should the Deanery Council fail to elect a youth member, not fewer than one nor more than two youth members shall be appointed by the chair and vice-chair of the Deanery Council from amongst the youth members elected or appointed from parishes/congregations in the Deanery. The expenses of the youth members shall be borne by his/her Deanery Council.) \*Note: the Youth Observer may be younger than 16.*
